Jesus Playing with the Neighborhood *Kids!* There was a boy named Judas, who Satan would seize, causing him to bite others and himself. One day Jesus' brothers, James and Joses (*Joseph's sons*), took Jesus to play with other children and Judas tried to bite him. When he could not do it, he struck Jesus on the right side and then Satan went out of him. This same boy was Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Jesus, and that same side on which Judas struck him, the Jesus pierced with a spear.

When Jesus was seven, he was playing with other boys his same age, who were making clay into animal figures. Jesus said to the boys, "I will command my figures to walk." Immediately they walked! He also made figures of birds, which when he commanded to fly, flew and ate! When the boys told their parents, they were forbidden to play with Jesus!

One day the Lord went to play in the streets with some boys, who hid themselves, leaving him to seek them. The Lord saw some women and asked where the boys had gone. The women answered that the boys were not there. The Lord said, "Then who are those kids (*young goats*) in the furnace?" Then he called out: "Come out of the furnace, O kids, to your shepherd." The boys came out leaping as kids! The women, trembling, worshipped him: "O our Lord Jesus, Son of Mary, You are the Good Shepherd. Have mercy on Your handmaids, who do not doubt; You, O Lord, are come to save and not destroy." Then Jesus said, "Come here boys that we may go and play," and immediately the kids were changed back into the shape of boys!

JESUS SAID, "I AM THE GOOD SHEPHERD. THE GOOD SHEPHERD LAYS DOWN HIS LIFE FOR THE SHEEP. NO ONE TAKES IT FROM ME, BUT I LAY IT DOWN OF MY OWN ACCORD" (JN. 10: 11, 18).

One occasion Jesus gathered the boys together and ranked them as though he were a king. They spread their garments on the ground for him to sit on, and made a crown of flowers and put it on his head, and stood on his right and left as the guards of a king. If anyone passed by, they took him by force, saying, "Come and worship the King that you may have a prosperous journey!"

One Sabbath day the Lord was playing with some boys by the river, making little channels and fish-pools. The Lord made 12 clay sparrows and placed them three on each side of his pool. A boy came by, accusing them: "Are you making figures of clay on the Sabbath?" Then the boy broke up the fish-pools. Jesus clapped his hands over the sparrows and they fled away, chirping. Then he said to the boy: "As this water has vanished, so will your life vanish." Soon after the boy died! Another time a boy ran hard against Jesus and threw him down. The Lord Jesus said: "As you have thrown me down, so will you fall and never rise." At that moment the boy fell down and died!

School Day! The schoolmaster said to Joseph, "Why don't you send Jesus to me so he can learn his letters?" Joseph and St. Mary brought him to the master, who asked Jesus to pronounce the first letter, *Aleph*. Jesus said it and then the master asked him to pronounce the second letter, *Beth*. Jesus said, "Tell me first the meaning of the letter *Aleph*, and then I will pronounce the second letter." When the master threatened to whip him, Jesus explained the meaning of all the letters, and many other things, and how to pronounce them correctly. The master, amazed, said, "I believe this boy was born before Noah! He has no need of learning." They brought him no more to the master. The master's hand withered for lifting it up to Jesus and then he died. Joseph said to St. Mary, "We will not allow him to go out of the house anymore, for everyone who displeases him is killed!" So he stayed home, studying and working with his father.

Jesus Teaching in the Temple: When Jesus was twelve, they went to Jerusalem for Passover. Jesus stayed behind when his parents went home; but they did not know it. After looking three days, they found him in the temple, teaching the law, prophets, astronomy, philosophy, physics, metaphysics, and how the soul operates on the body. After that Jesus concealed his miracles until he was thirty.



The Following Accounts were found in the book of the high-priest Caiaphas: He relates that Jesus spoke even when he was in the cradle, and said to his mother: "Mary, I am Jesus the Son of God, the Word which thou did bring forth according to the declaration of the angel Gabriel to thee. My Father sent me for the salvation of the world."

ADECREE WAS PUBLISHED that all person should be taxed; so Joseph, the spouse of Mary, left for Bethlehem, the city of his fathers. Mary was with child. During their journey, her time to bring forth came and she sought shelter in a cave. It was sunset, so Joseph hurried to find a midwife. When he found an old Hebrew woman, he brought her back to the cave and found it filled with lights, greater than the sun, and the infant Jesus sucking the breasts of his mother.

The old woman said to St. Mary, "You are very different from all other women." St. Mary answered, **"As there is not any child like to my son, so neither is there any woman like to his mother."** Eight days later Jesus was circumcised. The old woman took the foreskin to her son, a druggist, who preserved it in ointment. Thirty years later Mary Magdalene poured it on Jesus' feet. **Our Lady St. Mary presented (consecrated) Jesus to God** on the fortieth day (*Lk. 2:22*). When old Simeon saw him enter the temple, shining as a **pillar of light** with angels adoring and guarding him, he praised God: "**Mine eyes have seen thy mercy: a light to all people**." **CARD 5**

Wise men from the East came searching for Christ. King Herod sent them to Bethlehem. When they gave Jesus their offerings, the Lady Mary gave them one of his ***swaddling clothes**. When they returned home and showed the cloth to their fellow kings, a great feast was made. According to their custom, they worshipped the cloth and cast it into a fire. When the fire was put out, the cloth was unhurt, the fire could not burn it. With great respect they laid it up among their treasures. When the wise men did not return as vowed to King Herod, he began to contrive the death of the Lord Jesus Christ. But an angel appeared to Joseph in his sleep and told him to take the child and his mother and go into Egypt (cards 2, 7).

IN EGYPT Joseph and Mary lodged in a great city in an inn that was near an idol. Satan spoke out of the idol and a priest ministering to it related the things he said. This priest had a three-year old son who was possessed with a multitude of devils. The inhabitants were filled with great consternation over their coming and inquired to the idol of the meaning. The idol answered: **"The unknown God is come, who is truly God, and worthy of divine worship for He is the Son of God."** Then the idol fell down and the people ran in panic. The demon-possessed boy ran into the inn, where Our Lady St. Mary had just washed the swaddling clothes of Jesus and hung them out to dry. The boy put them on his head and immediately the devils came out of his mouth. Joseph and Mary, fearing the Egyptians would also try to kill them, fled to another city. **"IF ONLY I COULD TOUCH HIS GARMENT, I WILL BE HEALED"** (*Mr. 9:21*).

BEFORE CHRIST'S SECOND COMING, THE FALSE PROPHET IS GIVEN POWER TO GIVE LIFE TO AN IDOL SO THAT IT SPEAKS, ORDERING ALL WHO DO NOT WORSHIP IT TO BE KILLED (*Rev. 13/card 1*).

There a woman was running naked, possessed with a devil; when bound by chains, she would break them and throw rocks at people. When Mary pitied her, Satan left her, crying out: "Wo to me,

because of thee, Mary, and thy Son!" The woman's family entertained them and gave them sufficient provisions for the road. In the next town a marriage was about to be solemnized; but by the arts of Satan, sorcerers made the bride dumb, unable to speak her vows. When the bride saw the Lady St. Mary enter the town, carrying the Lord Christ in her arms, she went to them and held and kissed the infant. Immediately, her tongue was loosed and she began singing praises!

The next day the woman brought perfumed water to wash Jesus. With the preserved water a girl with leprosy was washed and instantly became cleansed of her leprosy. The girl asked Joseph and Mary if she could travel with them and they consented. In the next town the girl saw the wife of a prince crying and asked her the reason for her tears. She confided to the girl: "I brought forth a son,

who had leprosy. When my husband saw him, he would not own him to be his, and told me to either kill him or send him somewhere never to be heard of, and that he would never see me again." When the girl told her how she was cured of leprosy, the woman made a great feast for Joseph and Mary. With perfumed water she washed the infant Jesus and then poured the water on her son, who was instantly cured of his leprosy. The woman offered gifts to the Lady Mary to send them on their way.

In the next town they lodged with a newlywed man, who by the influence of sorcerers could not enjoy his wife. That night the man was freed from his disorder. In the next town they saw three women, weeping. Our Lady sent the girl to inquire what was the matter. The women invited them to stay with them and that evening confided their matter to St. Mary: "A woman by witchcraft has turned our brother into a mule." Mary put Jesus on the mule. When she said, "O JESUS CHRIST RESTORE, ACCORDING TO THY EXTRAORDINARY POWER, THIS MULE TO BE THE SHAPE OF A MAN," immediately, the mule passed into human form! NO PROBLEM Step BIG! As the women kissed Jesus, they said, "Blessed is thy mother, O Jesus, O Savior of the world!" Mary consented to wed the girl to their brother.

One night they were passing through a place infested with robbers, who were asleep. Titus and Dumachus were on guard. Titus said to Dumachus, "I will give you 40 pieces of silver if you let them pass and not wake the others." When the Lady St. Mary saw his kindness, she said, "The Lord will receive you to his right hand and GRANT YOU PARDON OF YOUR SINS." Jesus said, "In thirty years, O mother, the Jews will crucify me at Jerusalem with these two thieves. Titus will be on my right hand and go before me into paradise." Our Lady said, "God forbid this be thy lot my son."

They abode in Egypt for three years. Then an angel appeared in a dream to Joseph and told him to return to Nazareth, the city of Mary's birth. Many people came to the Lady St. Mary with their sick. She gave them Jesus' bath water to wash in or his swaddling clothes and they were all healed.

The Girl and the Dragon: There was a girl afflicted by Satan. He appeared to her as a dragon and sucked out her blood, making her look like a dead carcase. A princess, who had been cleansed of leprosy by washing in Jesus' bath water, saw her in her affliction. She asked the husband of the girl to call her parents. Then to the girl's mother, she confessed her secret: "I was leprous, but the Lady Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ, healed me." When St. Mary met the girl's mother, she gave her Jesus' bath water and told her to sprinkle it on her daughter's body. She also gave her one of Jesus' swaddling cloths, saying, "SHOW IT TO THE ENEMY, THE DRAGON, WHENEVER YOU SEE HIM." When the dragon saw the swaddling cloth of the Lord Jesus Christ, fire came from it and fell on him.
