

THE FUTURE IS NOW! BE PREPARED! PRAY FOR OUR ENEMIES: Jesus lived at the

cusp of the ages as it was passing from Aries into Pisces. We are living at the cusp of the ages, passing from Pisces into Aquarius. As Jesus and the twelve sat on Mount Olive overlooking Jerusalem, he foretold Jerusalem's future: "The time will come when every stone will be cast down and it will be scorned by the nations. Do not gather your wealth-flee! The tribulation cannot be foretold in words for such has never been seen. The conqueror will carry many captive. Those who do not know or love Israel's God will tread the highways of Jerusalem until the anti-Jewish times are fulfilled. (Jews and Palestinians claim Jerusalem as their capital. On December 6, 2017, President Trump announced that the U.S. recognizes Israel's claim. Extend your hands in prayer for the peace of Jerusalem.) The air will be surcharged with smoke of death, pestilence will follow. (December 2 is the anniversary of the San Bernardino massacre, where in 2015 a friend gunned down 14 of his co-workers. Killing sprees are now common place.) Signs will appear in heaven and earth, seas will roar (record hurricanes hit in 2017) and sounds coming from heaven will bring distress. Hearts will faint in the expectation of things to come. While conflicts rage on earth, the Prince of Peace will stand above the clouds and say: 'Peace, peace on earth, good will to all men!' Men will throw away their swords and nations will learn war no more. Then the man who bears the pitcher (Aquarius) will walk across an arc of heaven, the sign of the Son of man will stand forth in the eastern sky (longitude of the cusp). The wise will lift up their heads and know earth's redemption can be expected.

CARD 84: MARY'S CHRISTMAS MESSAGES 2017: "ASK THE LORD FOR THE GIFT OF FAITH!"

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TO OUR CONSCIENCES AS BELIEVERS, ALLOWING US TO GROW IN THE CONVICTION THAT SHARING WITH THE POOR ENABLES US TO UNDERSTAND THE DEEPEST TRUTH OF THE GOSPEL—THE POOR ARE NOT A PROBLEM, THEY ARE A RESOURCE FROM WHICH TO DRAW AS WE STRIVE TO ACCEPT AND PRACTICE IN OUR LIVES THE ESSENCE OF THE GOSPEL" (FRANCIS 11/19/17).

WORLD DAY OF THE POOR FALLS ON THE SUNDAY BETWEEN NOVEMBER 13-19. IT IS DONE AS AN ACT OF LOVE AND HUMILITY TO IMPOVERISH OURSELVES INTERIORLY BEFORE THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING ON THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY, WHO IMPOVERISHED HIMSELF FOR US (CARD 82). "DEAR CHILDREN: In this time of grace, I call you to prayer. Pray and seek peace. He who came here on earth to give you His peace, regardless

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of who you are and what you are—He, my Son, your Brother, through me is calling you to conversion because without God you do not have a future or eternal life. Therefore, believe and pray and live in grace and the **expectation** of your personal meeting with Him" (Med. 11/25/17).

STRIVE TO LOVE WITH WORDS AND DEEDS DONE FROM THE HEART, IF NOT What the Arrogant and the Holy and Humble Can Personally Expect!



"DEAR CHILDREN: I turn to you as your mother, the mother of the just, the mother of those who love and suffer, the mother of those who are holy. My children, you too can be holy, this depends on you. Those who are holy are those who immeasurably love the Heavenly Father, those who love Him above all. Therefore, my children, always strive to be better. If you strive to be good, you can be holy even though you may not think so of yourselves.

If you think you are good, you are not humble, arrogance distances you from holiness.

"In this peaceless world full of threats, your hands, apostles of my love, should be extended in prayer and mercy; and to me, my children, give the gift of the rosary, the roses which I love so much. My roses are your prayers pronounced with the heart and not only recited with the lips. My roses are your acts of prayer, faith and love. When my Son was little, he said to me that my children would be numerous and that they would bring me many roses. I did not comprehend Him. Now I know that you are those children who are bringing me roses when above all you love my Son, when you pray with the heart, when you help the poorest. Those are my roses. That is the faith which makes everything in life be done through love, not knowing arrogance, and always ready to forgive; never judging, always striving to understand one's brother.

"Therefore, apostles of my love, pray for those who do not know how to love, for those who do not love you, for those who have done evil to you, and for those who have not come to know the love of my Son. My children, I ask this of you because remember to pray means to love and to forgive." Thank you" (Med. 12/02/17).

THE AQUARIAN GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST was transcribed by Levi H. Dowling from the Akashic Records (card 63). This card is part of an ongoing series, in which the text is enhanced with Mary's ongoing messages from Medjugorje and includes excerpts from Pope Francis' message initiating the first World Day to serve the poor, held on November 19, 2017. He says, "Love has no alibi." This means to not judge but to forgive and strive to love and understand our brothers. He invites us to follow Jesus, the King, who lived in poverty and encountered and embraced the poor. "Poverty means having a humble heart that accepts our limitations and thus enables us to overcome the temptation to feel omnipotent and immortal. Poverty is an interior attitude that avoids looking upon money, career and luxury as our goal in life and the condition for our happiness." Mary ask us to recite her rosary and extend our hands in prayer, seeking mercy to overcome the evil threatening our peace (cards 76, 18/sacred processions). Pray for the conversion of our brother in North Korea, who in his arrogance thinks he is omnipotent and immortal, and that all our enemies would be humble before God! ARROGANT EMPTY WORDS AND FRUITLESS DEEDS—WHAT TO EXPECT: Jesus and his apostles were on their way from Bethany to Jerusalem the week prior to his final Passover. He saw a fig tree full of beautiful leaves, but it had no fruit. He said, "You arrogant, useless cumberer of the ground, fair to look upon, but a delusive thing. You take from the earth all the rich food that poor fruitful trees need. Go back to the earth and be yourself the food for other trees." In Jerusalem the temple had become a mart of trade, filled with merchants selling holy sacrificial things for profit. Indignant, Jesus said, "This is suppose to be a house of prayer, but it is now a den of thieves, remove this plunder from this holy place!" The merchants arrogantly replied, "We will not go, our trade is protected by our rulers." Jesus threw their money and plunder on the floor and drove them out with a scourge. Then he swept the floor with a clean new broom.

POPE FRANCIS: "'LITTLE CHILDREN, LET US NOT LOVE IN WORD OR SPEECH, BUT IN DEED AND IN TRUTH.' THESE WORDS OF THE APOSTLE JOHN VOICE AN IMPERATIVE THAT NO CHRISTIAN MAY DISREGARD. THE SERIOUSNESS WITH WHICH THE BELOVED DISCIPLE HANDS DOWN JESUS' COMMAND TO OUR OWN DAY IS MADE EVEN CLEARER BY THE CONTRAST BETWEEN THE EMPTY WORDS SO FREQUENTLY ON OUR LIPS AND THE CONCRETE DEEDS AGAINST WHICH WE ARE CALLED TO MEASURE OURSELVES. LOVE HAS NO ALIBI. WHENEVER WE SET OUT TO LOVE AS JESUS LOVED, WE HAVE TO TAKE THE LORD AS OUR EXAMPLE, ESPECIALLY WHEN IT COMES TO LOVING THE POOR" (WORLD DAY OF THE POOR 11/19/17).

In the evening he returned to Bethany. The next morning on their way back the apostles observed that the fig tree's leaves had withered, as if scorched by fire. Jesus said, "So will it be with those who bear no fruit. When God calls them up to give account, he will breathe upon them, and their leaves, their arrogant empty words, will wither. He will not let the fruitless trees take the food from the trees in need, he will pluck them up and cast them away."

THE ARROGANT AND THE HUMBLE-WHAT TO EXPECT: The next day the Pharisees and scribes, emboldened by those in power, said arrogantly to Jesus, "Who gave you authority to do what you did?" He replied, "I will tell you if you will answer this—was John a holy man of God or a seditious man, inciting rebellion?" They did not want to answer him, reasoning, "If we say John was a holy prophet, then he will argue why did we not believe his words and get baptized? If we say he was a seditious man, the people will be angry for they believe he was a holy prophet sent from God." So they answered, "We cannot tell." Jesus said, "Then I cannot tell you who gave me power to drive the robbers from God's house." Then he spoke a parable: "A king made a **feast** and **invited** all the rich and honored people of the land. But when they came, they found the door into the banquet hall was so low that they could not enter unless they humbled themselves and bowed their heads and fell down on their knees, so they left. Then the king sent his messengers to offer the invitation to feast with him to the common folks of poor estate, who welcomed the invitation and gladly bowed their heads and fell on their knees. You priests, scribes and Pharisees, the Lord of all has spread a sumptuous feast and offered you his invitation first, but when you found the door was so low that you had to humble yourselves to enter, you scorned the king, refusing his invitation and went your way. Therefore, God has invited those of poor estate to go into his kingdom and you are left without. John came in 🚢 holiness and brought you the truth, but you believed him not. They believed and were baptized and now have entered into the feast. Many have been invited, but few are chosen."

IF YOU SERVE THE POOREST, EXPECT TO BE THE GREATEST: A good scribe asked Jesus, "Which is the greatest command?" Jesus replied, "You shall immeasurable love the Heavenly Father above all and your neighbor as yourself." The scribe responded, "My heart welcomes the truth you speak for love fulfills the law." Jesus said, "You are within the kingdom and the kingdom is in you. But beware of the Pharisees who strut about in their arrogance, taking the hard-earned wages of the poor to satisfy their carnal selves. They pray with their lips, but not with their deeds. They are placed by the law in Moses' seat, so do what they say, but do not act like them. They talk of mercy and helpfulness, yet they do not make the slightest effort to help their brothers in need. To be exalted sit at the master's feet and serve, strive to be good and do better even though you think you cannot. He is the greatest who serves the poorest best."

POPE FRANCIS: "GOD LOVED US BY GIVING COMPLETELY OF HIMSELF, EVEN TO LAYING DOWN HIS LIFE. SUCH LOVE CANNOT GO UNANSWERED. EVEN THOUGH OFFERED UNCONDITIONALLY, ASKING NOTHING IN RETURN, IT SO SETS HEARTS ON FIRE THAT ALL WHO EXPERIENCE IT ARE LED TO LOVE BACK, DESPITE THEIR LIMITATIONS AND SINS. YET THIS CAN ONLY HAPPEN IF WE WELCOME GOD'S GRACE, HIS MERCIFUL CHARITY, AS FULLY AS POSSIBLE INTO OUR HEARTS, SO THAT OUR WILL AND EVEN OUR EMOTIONS ARE DRAWN TO LOVE BOTH GOD AND NEIGHBOR. IN THIS WAY, THE MERCY THAT WELLS UP, AS IF IT WERE FROM THE HEART OF THE TRINITY, CAN SHAPE OUR LIVES AND BRING FORTH COMPASSION AND WORKS OF MERCY FOR THE BENEFIT OF OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN NEED" (WORLD DAY 11/19/17).
