

“DEAR CHILDREN: My earthly life was simple, I loved and I rejoiced in small things. I loved life, the gift from God, even though pain and sufferings pierced my heart. My children, **I had the strength of faith and boundless trust in God’s love.** All those who have the strength of faith are stronger. Faith makes you live according to what is good and then **the light of God’s love always comes at the desired moment—that is the strength which sustains in pain and suffering.** My children pray for the strength of faith, trust in the Heavenly Father and do not be afraid. Know that not a single creature who belongs to God will be lost, but will live forever. Every pain has its end and then life in freedom begins there where all of my children come—where everything is returned! My children your battle is difficult, it will be even more difficult, but you follow my example—pray for the strength of faith, trust in the love of the Heavenly Father. I am with you, I am manifesting myself to you! I am encouraging you with immeasurable motherly love, I am caressing your souls!” (Med. 3/18/18 annual message to Mirjana).

† **JESUS HAS STRENGTH OF FAITH AND BOUNDLESS TRUST IN GOD’S LOVE:** Herod’s guards drove Jesus to Calvary with swords. Mary and the women who loved Jesus tenderly were close beside him weeping. Jesus said, “Do not weep for me for even though I go through the gateway of the Cross, have hope for on the day after the Sabbath I will meet you at the sepulchre.” At Calvary two criminals had been bound to their crosses with cords by Pilate’s soldiers. Herod’s four guards stripped Jesus, laid him on a Cross and would have bound him, but the cruel mob had a hammer and nails and cried, “Not cords, but nails!” The guards drove the nails through Jesus’ feet and hands and offered him a sedative to drink of vinegar and myrrh, but he refused the draught. They raised his Cross between the two criminals, then sat down to mock him with the mob and watched him die! Jesus said, “My Father-God forgive them, they do not know what they are doing.” Pilate had a sign placed on the Cross which read: Jesus the Christ, King of the Jews! This angered the priests, scoffing at Jesus. The mob looked at him upon the Cross and said, “Hail, fake king! If you are the Christ, the Son of God, show us a sign, come down from the Cross and we will believe in you.” Then one of the criminals joined in the mocking. The other one, rebuking him, said, “Do you not fear God? We are guilty and paying debts we owe, but he is innocent.” He said to Jesus, “Lord, I know your kingdom comes, a kingdom the world cannot comprehend. When you come on the clouds, remember me.” Jesus said, “I will meet you in the realm of souls today, do not fear being lost, you will live forever.” Jesus said to John, “In your tender care I leave my mother and the singer Miriam” (card 76).

† **THE LIGHT OF GOD’S LOVE COMES AT THE DESIRED MOMENT:** At noon it became as dark as night and Jesus cried, “Thou sun, why have you forsaken me?” He became thirsty and Pilate’s soldier dipped a sponge in the draught and put it on his lips. At 3 p.m. the earth quaked and a flood of golden light appeared above Jesus’ Cross and a voice spoke, “It is done!” Jesus cried, “My Father-God into your hands I give my soul!” Pilate’s soldier said, “His agony is too great, relief shall come.” In compassion he pierced Jesus’ heart with a spear and his pain and suffering ended and he was dead. The earth shook, tombs opened, the dead arose and walked the streets (card 19). The temple shook and the holy veil tore in two. The soldier declared, “This was the Son of God!” The mob ran in fear! Pilate allowed Nicodemus and Joseph, two rabbis who loved Jesus, to take his body. They tenderly prepared it and laid it in a tomb. The priests asked Pilate to send his soldiers to guard the tomb, fearing Jesus’ disciples would steal the body and say he arose from the dead as he had claimed. He told them to send a 100 of their own.

CARD 9: THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES • CARD 24: THE WAY OF THE CROSS



MARY AND JOHN STOOD BEFORE THE CROSS. JESUS SAID TO HIS MOTHER, “HERE IS YOUR SON.” HE SAID TO JOHN, “HERE IS YOUR MOTHER.” MARY WENT HOME WITH HIM AND LIVED A SIMPLE AND GOOD LIFE EVEN THOUGH IT WAS MORE DIFFICULT (JOHN 19: 25-27 WITH MARY’S MESSAGE).

CARD 15 IS AN OVERVIEW OF MARY’S MESSAGES FROM MEDJUGORJE

CURRENT CALENDAR EVENT: HOLY WEEK IN 2018 IS IN MARCH DURING WHICH TIME WE TENDERLY REMEMBER JESUS’ PAIN AND SUFFERING UPON THE CROSS.



OUR LADY OF MEDJUGORJE appeared to Mirjana Dragicevic-Soldo daily from June 1981 to December 1982. During the last daily apparition, Mary gave her the 10th secret prophecy and told her that she would appear to her annually on her birthday, **March 18th.** In 1987, Mary began to appear to her monthly on the **2nd** and taught her privately. Then on October 2, 2004, she instructed her to share her ongoing messages with the world.

JESUS REDEEMS THE WORLD THROUGH HIS PAIN AND SUFFERING † The Holy Breath Speaks to Souls and Hearts and Teaches the Truth!



“DEAR CHILDREN: Great are the works that the Heavenly Father has done in me, as He does in all those who love Him tenderly and who faithfully and devoutly serve Him. My children, the Heavenly Father loves you and it is through His love that **I am here with you — He is speaking to you!** Why do you not desire to see the **signs?** Everything is easier alongside Him. Also pain lived with Him is easier because faith exists. Faith helps in the pain, and pain without faith leads to despair. **Pain lived and offered to God raises up. Did my Son not redeem the world through His painful sacrifice?** As His mother I was with Him in the pain and suffering, as I am with all of you.

“My children, **I am with you in life**, in suffering, in pain, in joy and in love; therefore, have hope! It is hope that makes you comprehend that life is there. **My children, I am speaking to you, my voice is speaking to your soul, my heart is speaking to your heart.** Oh, apostles of my love, how much my motherly heart loves you. **How many things I desire to teach you.** How my motherly heart desires that you be complete, and you can be complete only when your soul, body and love are united within you. I implore you as my children, pray much for the Church and her servants—your shepherds—that the Church may be such as my Son desires—**clear as spring water** and full of love. Thank you” (Med. 3/2/18 monthly message to Mirjana).

THE AQUARIAN GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST was transcribed by Levi H. Dowling from the Akashic Records in the realm of souls, where he was taught by the Mother-Goddess of Wisdom. It is a translation of the Gospel that was lost but preserved in these archives. This card is part of a series in which our Holy Mother’s voice speaks to my soul and teaches me how to weave her ongoing messages and current calendar events into the lost Gospel, beginning with her November 2, 2016 message (card 63). I wrote my first Gospel card, ***The Sorrowful Mysteries***, in 2002 (card 9). In 2003, Mary began to awaken me at 3 a.m. daily, speaking to my soul, instructing me to complete the set of Rosary cards and cards on her many apparitions and the end-time prophecies (cards 1–14). I learned of her apparitions at **Medjugorje** in 2009 and wrote card 15, an overview of her messages from 1981 to 2010. In October 2013, **I witnessed a painful situation, causing Jesus to suffer.** I became inspired to write a prayer entitled, **“The Way and the Power of the Cross.”** On December 2, 2013, Mary gave Mirjana a powerful message on the way of the Cross and instructed me to write a card, include the prayer and weave her message into the Gospel (card 24). From then on our Holy Mother has instructed me to write cards for her ongoing messages. In 2014, she instructed me to write two cards about the **painful situation**, using her September and October messages in which she refers to Jesus as the **“Spring of Clear Water.”** Her heart is speaking to mine! Her repeated words are a **sign** to share this **situation** with you as you remember **Jesus’ sacrifice on the Cross—the powerful sign of God’s love** (cards 30, 29). Section XIX: 167–171, “Trial and Execution.”

† **JESUS REDEEMS THE WORLD THROUGH HIS PAINFUL SACRIFICE UPON THE CROSS:** Jesus was tried by two Jewish courts, who used false witnesses to sentence him to death. They wanted him to suffer a painful death upon a Cross but needed consent from their Roman rulers, so a mob dragged him to the governor (card 86). Under Jewish law if they entered the Gentile’s palace during Passover week, they would be defiled, unable to attend the feasts, so Pilate met them outside in the court. He asked, “What is your prayer?” They answered, “We bring an evil and seditious man, whom we tried before our highest court and proved he is a traitor to our laws, our state, and the government of Rome. **We pray that you sentence him to death upon a Cross †.**”

Pilate said, “Why are you bringing him to me? Under Roman rule you have a right to judge and execute him.” The Jews replied, “We have no right to execute him upon a Cross. Since he is a traitor to King Tiberius, our counsellors believe he should meet the most humiliating death—the death upon a Cross!” Pilate said, “Under Roman law no man can be found guilty until the accused has been permitted to defend himself. I will take your charges and judge him by Roman law.” The Jews gave him a copy of the charges and added: “We charge that Jesus is an enemy of Rome for he demands men not to pay tribute to King Tiberius Caesar.” His soldiers led Jesus into the palace. Pilate read the charges and asked, “Are these charges true or false?”

✦ **JESUS TESTIFIES THE HOLY BREATH SPEAKS TO SOULS AND HEARTS AND TEACHES TRUTH:**

The Aquarian Gospel teaches the Church about the motherly aspect of the Holy Breath (card 85). Jesus answered, “Why should I plead before an earthly court, against charges verified by perjured witnesses? Yes, it is true as charged I am a king. But carnal men cannot see the king nor the kingdom of God for it is within the soul. If I were a king as carnal men, my servants would have defended me and I would not have willingly surrendered to Jewish officials. Men are not my witnesses. God is my witness and my words and deeds testify to the truth. If you want to comprehend the truth, listen to my words and in your soul and heart you will be given witness of me.” Pilate asked, “What is truth?” Jesus testified, “Truth is the God who knows all—it is the Changeless One—the Holy Breath is truth—She changes not and cannot pass away.” Pilate pronounced to the Jews, “Jesus is guilty of no crime and I cannot sentence him to death.” The mob shouted, “He perverts our nation and wants to overthrow Roman’s rule and make himself a king. He is a culprit from Galilee and must be crucified!” Pilate said, “If he is from Galilee, he is a subject of Herod.” Pilate sent Jesus to Herod in chains and asked him to pass judgement. Herod asked Jesus about his claims. When he would not answer, Herod instructed his guards to torture him until he did. Four cruel guards hit him. Then mocking him, they wrapped him in a royal robe and stuck a crown of thorns in his head and said deridingly, “All hail, thou king!” When Jesus still did not answer, Herod sent him back to Pilate, yielding his right to judge.

THE JEWS AND THEIR SHEPHERDS ARE UNITED IN SOUL AND BODY AND FULL OF RAGE: Pilate told the Jews again, “There is no evidence that Jesus should suffer death upon a Cross. I will scourge him and let him go.” The Jews shouted, “He is dangerous and must be crucified!” Pilate left and sat in silent thought. His wife warned him that she had a dream that if he scourged Jesus, he would be scourging the Son of God! The Jews had a perverted tradition, during the feasts Pilate would release a condemned prisoner, who became their scapegoat. They believed that by releasing him and ceremonially heaping their sins upon him and then driving him into exile, they were released from sin. Barabbas, a notorious criminal, had bought the priests and was chosen. Pilate tried to get the Jews to release Jesus instead of Barabbas and send him into exile and hear no more of him. This enraged the mob, who began to plot to tear his palace down and drive him into exile. Fearing civil war, Pilate took a bowl of water and washing his hands said, “The man you accuse is Son of the holy Gods and I proclaim my innocence. If you shed his blood, it will be on your hands and not mine.” The Jews shouted, “Let his blood be on our hands and our children’s hands!” Pilate released Barabbas and as Jesus stood before the Jews he said, “Behold, your king! Will you put your king to death?” The mob shouted, “We have no king but Tiberius!” When Pilate would not give consent for Roman soldiers to soak their hands in innocent blood, Caiaphas, the Jews high priest, said to the counsel, “We cannot crucify him, we must stone him to death!” As the mob led Jesus outside the city to Calvary, where criminals were put to death, they hit him, spat on him, and in a frenzy stoned him until he fell to the ground. A Pharisee shouted, “Stop! Herod’s guards are coming to crucify him.” Jesus, bruised and mangled, could not bear his Cross, so they laid it on Simon, a loving friend.
